Dear Member,

At least 52 Members attended the Annual General Meeting at Staplefield on March 16th. Mr. R. Stern was elected Chairman, giving up his position as Field Convener for West Sussex. Mr. A. Knapp was elected to that vacancy. All other Officers and Committee were re-elected en bloc.

The Treasurer's report showed that subscription income had slightly exceeded expenditure, so with the approx. £150 profit from the Bring and Buy last November there was no need to raise the subscription for 1987, which will remain at £2. However it was proposed and agreed that a similar effort should be made at the Get-together next November, "as there are many things for which money would be useful". Genus *Rosa*

The Author of the B.S.B.I. *Rosa* reference book for beginners, Rev. A. L. Primavesi, is willing to accept rose specimens for naming. Send a small fruiting spray and a 20cm. length of stem displaying typical spines. Attach reference numbers and keep records as the specimens will not be returned. (Fresh specimens in polythene bags in padded mail bags or small cardboard boxes). The specimens should be collected before the fruit is ripe, and before the sepals fall off. Send with S.A.E. to Rev. A. L. Primavesi, Ratcliffe College, Syston, Leicester, LE7 8SG.

*Rosa stylosa* Our Recorders are asking for a special effort from mid August to early October 1986 to record *Rosa stylosa* in Sussex. Send records to Mrs. Briggs or Mrs. Eurt with grid reference, locality, note on the habitat, date, your name, and name of referee if one has been consulted.
